


Young Women's Leadership Summit Art Contest

To celebrate this year's theme, *"bloom where you are planted"*, we want to see your artistic talents! Submit your entry in this year's art contest showing us how you interpret the meaning of the theme through one of the art mediums described below. Entries will be reviewed for interpretation of theme, creativity and technique. All participants will have their artwork displayed at the Larson Gallery and the top winners receive amazing prizes!

Art mediums you may use to show us how you interpret, *"bloom where you are planted"*:

- Painting
- Drawing/Sketching
- Collage
- Photography
- Poetry
- Short story
- Reflective essay
- Computer generated digital art



Entry guidelines:

- Each entry must be the original work of the artist only. To encourage unique expressions of the theme from young women, help from an adult or collaboration with others is not allowed. Other individuals may appear in the artwork with their permission, but the work itself must be the creative product of the artist only.
- All entries must fit on a standard letter-sized paper (8.5" x 11") *Paper is included in your *Summit* Box*
- Written entries must be at least size 12 point font
- Contestants are encouraged to include a title and an artist statement describing what inspired the work and how it relates to the theme.
- Entries must be submitted by JUNE 1, 2021 2:30pm
- Winners will be announced by the end of the school year and contacted to receive their prize.

How to submit your artwork:

Bring your completed art project and the Submission form (included in your box) to your school counselor before 2:30pm on June 1st. All forms must be filled out clearly.
